As president of the Shikoku Muchujin (Dreamers), I'd like to extend my thanks to you for being interested in the Teshima Paradise Island Project.



So far we have organized a Henro pilgrimage, a Haiku tour, and Japanese culture courses such as the tea ceremony and Bonsai for foreign bloggers and asked them to promote tourism in Shikoku on the SNS since 2008. We also introduced local food such as Udon noodles at Japan Expo in France in 2008. We have been spreading information about products local companies produce through grass-roots means.

We hope to explore the rich but as yet untapped resources of Teshima Island for potential visitors to this area. We supported the exchange between Kyoto University students and the inhabitants of Teshima Island through various activities such as camping, maintaining bamboo forests, planting flower seedlings and cleaning the beach. Our goal is to diversify the tourism of Shikoku and revitalize the community. We are trying to make more and more Japanese experiences available to foreigners and set up paths that allow for cultural exchange.
